 $W_{\it e}$  begin with our RESURRECTION LESSON.

First, Resurrection can only be accomplished by God. Christians believe in resurrected eternal life. God is the one who brings life and takes it away. God is the one who brings the second, eternal life. And when we think about resurrection, we usually think about Jesus, who was killed and resurrected from the dead three days later. And while that event plays a large part in the subject of resurrection, since it is the basis of our hope for eternal life, it isn't all we're talking about here.


Second, Jesus' resurrection prefigures our own. That's a fancy way of saying that God has promised to do for us what God already did for Jesus. But this still leaves us with some questions about how this will all take place. When Paul was asked this question back in Bible times, he wrote this: "But someone will ask, 'How are the dead raised? With what kind of body do they come?' Fool!" (1 Cor. 15:35-36). In other words, "There is no such thing as a stupid question--only stupid people who ask questions!" We just trust this promise: God raised Jesus; God will raise us, too.

And finally, every single day, we are being resurrected. In a very real way, we die in our sins every single day. Our lives are dead and worthless through our constant sin and rebellion. Howe ver, in the act of continual for giveness granted us through God's grace, we are reborn anew, forgiven, resurrected humans. This is an actual resurrection. Our sins kill us, but God's for giveness makes us alive again.
