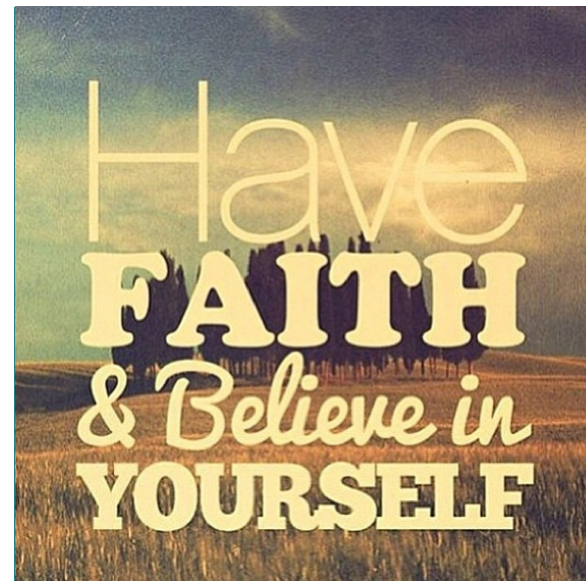
NEWS & EVENTS

New Business- Weeds will sprayed around church parking lot.

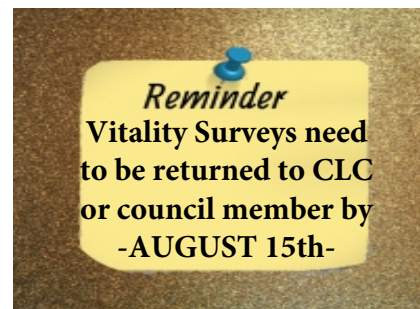
August FOM- Not determined yet.
