Coming from the Greek word orthos ("right") and doxa ("opinion"), to be orthodox means to do or believe correctly. In many spheres of life, right and wrong do not apply (now remember I said, "many spheres" not all). There is no right side of the bread to butter, no right side of your head on which to part your hair—the left just as often looks better. Likewise, there is no right style of for worship. Orthodoxy is best applied to doctrine, confession of faith, spiritual-mindedness (see Psalm 51), and cheering for particular baseball teams (i.e., "Let's Go ROY-ALS").
