The monthly meeting of the Christ Lutheran Church Council was called to order on Thursday, May 22, 2025 at 12:05 p.m. at the Christ Lutheran Church Bell Tower Room by President Camille Frakes. C. Frakes, Bruce Hawthorne, Karla Fowler, Shannon Rockhill and Pastor SueEllen Wenthe were present; Butch DeHaven was absent. Pres. Frakes shared a devotion for inspirational time surrounding those who lead others to Christ. Pastor SueEllen led the opening prayer. The minutes of the previous minutes were read. A motion was made to approve the minutes by S. Rockhill. C. Frakes seconded and the motion passed. The financial report was reviewed and higher than normal expenses for utilities were discussed as well looking into getting quotes for insurance. After discussion, B. Hawthorne made a motion to approve the financial report. K. Fowler seconded and motion passed.

For correspondence, Pres. Frakes shared the April First of the Month Offering brought in \$188.00 for Kristy Zimmers. Pastor SueEllen shared the Eureka High School Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) gifted the church a nice sign that they displayed at their end of year banquet. For the Youth Committee's Report, Pres. Frakes announced the Christ's Kids Club will be taking a summer field trip to the Sedgwick County Zoo on Sunday, June 22, 2025 where the church's youth account will pay for the admission to the zoo for the Christ's Kids Club participants. She also mentioned that there is a possibility of additional volunteers where the Christ's Kids Club could meet every Wednesday during the 2025-2026 school year. S. Rockhill shared the last Christ's Kids Club of the 2024-2025 school year was held the previous night at the city park which included a barbeque and was well attended with 12 children present.

For the Property Committee's Report, it was shared that the baby changing table purchased in April needs to be installed. There are lights in the basement, hallway to the basement, and Bell Tower Room that are not currently working that B. Hawthorne will work on fixing. B. Hawthorne suggested replacing the lights in the Bell Tower Room with LED lights when the current light bulbs need replaced. The east front doors and the back Bell Tower Room door are in need of being refinished due to the harsh sun exposure; B. Hawthorne will contact Mark Hayes with Moonlight Construction to see if he will be able to complete this. B. Hawthorne will also continue to spray weeds as necessary around the church property and remove birds' nest that are located outside the basement doors. There was no WELCA Committee Report.

For the Pastor's Report, Pastor SueEllen shared her activities completed throughout the month of April which included 2 lenten Bible studies, 8 regular church services plus Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services, attended and helped with 2 Christ's Kids Clubs and shared Bible lessons, zoom class with Bishop Candea and Rev. Adam Wutka, Ministerial Alliance Meeting, located and purchased Palm branches in El Dorado for Palm Sunday Service, helped serve the Community LINC meal, gave communion to Delores Curnutt at Wesley Hospital in Wichita, updated the Congressional Record Book for members that have passed, picked out hymns for May services with Margaret Spires, made many phone calls, texts and in home visits, and helped prepare church service bulletins. She wrote an article to submit to The Eureka Herald sharing the news of a new pastor at Christ Lutheran Church that will be published. She also shared that she and Lawrence, her husband, have been busy fixing up the parsonage and outbuilding when he is in town and he will be trimming trees that need trimmed as he has time.

For Old Business, Wednesday evening services were discussed. The last Wednesday evening service had one person attend. Pastor SueEllen will hold the Wednesday evening services through the month of June and then reassess. A contemporary church service was discussed and planned for Sunday, June 22, 2025 at 10:30. It will be held at the Eureka City Park. Pres. Frakes will send invitations out and post information so the congregation and community will hopefully join for a fun morning worship.


